



## **THE HOLY DAYS OF OBLIGATION**

**The Archdiocese Liturgical Commission voted to have them implemented with the New Liturgical Year beginning with the First Sunday of Advent – November 27, 2022.**

**January 01** – Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God

**March 25** – Feast of the Annunciation

**Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter** – Solemnity of the Ascension  
of the Lord

**August 15** – Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

**November 01** – Feast of All Saints

**December 08** – Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception

**December 25** – Solemnity of the Nativity of Our Lord Jesus Christ

*NOTE: Whenever January 1, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, or August 15, the Solemnity of the Assumption, or November 1, the Solemnity of All Saints falls on a Saturday or on a Monday, the precept to attend Mass is abrogated (abolished).*
